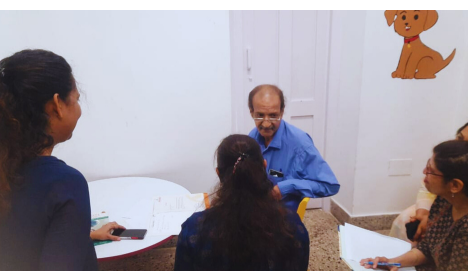
JUNE 5 WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

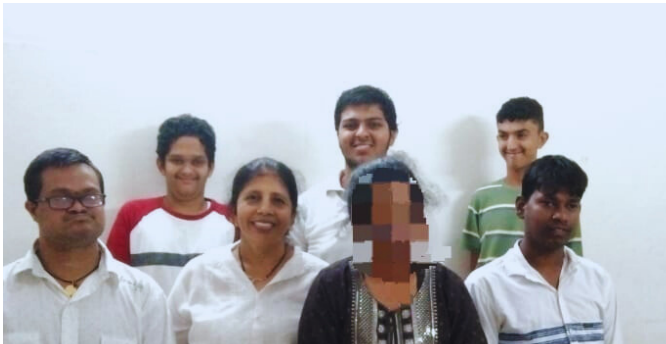

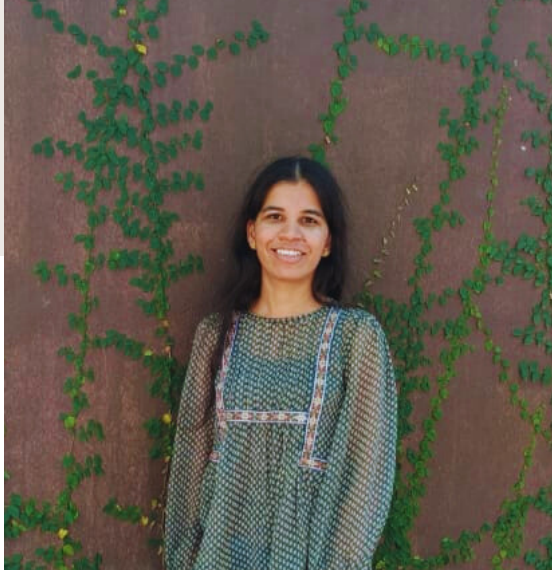
